Senator Tippins of the 37th offers the following amendment:

1 *Amend the Senate Health and Human Services Committee substitute to HB 1 (LC 37 1997S)*
2 *by replacing "to provide for an effective date;" with "to provide for effective dates;" on line*
3 *17.*

4 *By replacing lines 261 and 262 with the following:*

5 (a) As used in this chapter, the term 'low THC oil' means an oil that contains not more than
6 5 percent by weight of tetrahydrocannabinol and an amount of cannabidiol equal to or
7 greater than the amount of tetrahydrocannabinol.

8 *By revising lines 361 and 362 to read as follows:*

9 (a) Except as otherwise provided by subsection (b) of this section, this Act shall become
10 effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
11 (b) Sections 1-2, 2-1, and 5-1 shall become effective only upon the effective date of enacted
12 federal law authorizing the possession, dispensation, and administration of low THC oil as
13 defined in Code Section 16-12-190 as enacted by Section 1-2 of this Act.
