1 Congratulating the Brunswick High School Basketball Team on winning the 2015 GHSA
2 Class AAAAA State Championship; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, through training, talent, and iron will, the Brunswick High School Basketball
4 Team claimed the Class AAAAA State Championship with a hard-earned 49-32 victory over
5 second-ranked Allatoona High School; and

6 WHEREAS, it became the first team among the school's three major sports to win a state title
7 and join 2008 individual state champion golfer, Katie Burnett, at the pinnacle of the school's
8 athletic trophy case; and

9 WHEREAS, Region 3-AAAAA player of the year, Roger Davis, led the Pirates in the
10 victory, scoring 20 points, pulling down 14 rebounds, and blocking four shots; and

13 game ranked number three in the Class AAAAA poll; and

15 best in school history, and were named the region tournament and regular season region
16 champions; and

17 WHEREAS, team members include Darius Lampkin, Jaylen Jackson, Zach Moore, Nigel
18 Lawson, Jabril Heck, Skylar Baggs, Matthony Mangram, Roger Davis, Lamar Beckham,
19 Elijah Alston, Kymani Dunham, Michael Bostic, DaQuan Humphries, Chris Reed, and
20 Danijah Gammage; and

21 WHEREAS, the standout Pirates were led by their dedicated head coach Chris Turner and
22 athletic director Steve Waters; and

23 WHEREAS, the phenomenal performance of the team is a clear indication of the outstanding
24 athletic ability, the dedication and hard work, and the unity of purpose and spirit of each
25 member of the team, their superb offensive and defensive talents, and the astute direction of
26 their coaches; and
