AS PASSED SENATE

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1 To amend an Act entitled "An Act to reincorporate and provide a new charter for the City of
2 Acworth," approved February 17, 1989 (Ga. L. 1989, p. 3512), as amended, particularly by
3 an Act approved March 20, 1990 (Ga. L. 1990, p. 4736), an Act approved April 17, 1992
4 (Ga. L. 1992, p. 6445), an Act approved March 30, 1993 (Ga. L. 1993, p. 4245), and an Act
5 approved September 21, 1995 (Ga. L. 1995, Ex. Sess., p. 322), so as to change the corporate
6 boundaries; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 An Act entitled "An Act to reincorporate and provide a new charter for the City of Acworth,"
10 approved February 17, 1989 (Ga. L. 1989, p. 3512), as amended, particularly by an Act
11 approved March 20, 1990 (Ga. L. 1990, p. 4736), an Act approved April 17, 1992 (Ga. L.
12 1992, p. 6445), an Act approved March 30, 1993 (Ga. L. 1993, p. 4245), and an Act
13 approved September 21, 1995 (Ga. L. 1995, Ex. Sess., p. 322), is amended by adding at the
14 end of Section 1.11 a new subsection (g) to read as follows:

15 "(g) In addition to any other property included within the corporate limits of the city, such
16 corporate limits shall also include that property lying and being in Land Lots 41, 42, 43,
17 72, and 73 of the 20th District, 2nd Section, of Cobb County, said property totaling 316.47
18 acres, more or less."

19 **SECTION 2.**

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
