3 School's Class of 1970; and

4 WHEREAS, the Atlanta Public School System established Frederick Douglass High School

5 to relieve overcrowding at nearby Harper, Turner, and West Fulton High Schools, and

6 Frederick Douglass High School opened in August of 1968 with grades eight through 11; and

7 WHEREAS, the school was located at 225 Hightower Road, which is now known as

8 Hamilton E. Holmes Drive, Atlanta, Georgia, and on May 18, 1970, 357 students graduated

9 at the Civic Center in downtown Atlanta, Georgia; and

10 WHEREAS, the first principal was Dr. Lester W. Butts, the assistant principals were Mr. H.

11 Harris and Mrs. J. Daniel, Atlanta Public School superintendent was Dr. S. W. Letson, and

12 Area Four superintendent was Mr. Cecil Thornton; and

WHEREAS, for the Class of 1970, David Carr was the first class president and the second was Ronald Sailor; the first co-captains of the football team were Adrian Malone, Jesse Mobley, and Stanley Cobb, and the co-captains for the basketball team were Stanley Jefferson, David Carr, and junior classmate Bernard Roberson; the first Miss Douglass High School Queen was Denise Tremier, and the first runner up was Barbara Denson; and

WHEREAS, before becoming the Mighty Astros, many recommendations for school mascot
names were suggested, including the Squirrels and the Ducks; the dynamic school colors are
and will forever be black and gold.
