

**NOT GERMANE**

Senator Parent of the 42nd offers the following amendment:

1 *Amend HB 85 (HB 85/FA) by deleting "Chapter 3 of" on lines 1 and 12, deleting "the*  
 2 *regulation of" on lines 1 through 2 and 12, and by deleting "generally" on lines 2 and 13.*

3 *By inserting after "so as" on line 2 the following: to change provisions relating to the sale or*  
 4 *provision of alcoholic beverages on or near certain public and private locations; by inserting*  
 5 *after "hospital;" on line 8 the following: to allow brewpubs to sell malt beverages for*  
 6 *consumption off of the premises; and by inserting between lines 67 and 68 the following:*  
 7 **SECTION 2A.** Said title is further amended by revising subparagraph (C) of paragraph (2)  
 8 and paragraph (4) of Code Section 3-5-36, relating to brewpubs and the limited exception to  
 9 the prohibition against ownership and employment interests between manufacture,  
 10 distribution, and sale of malt beverages, as follows:

11 ~~"(C)(D)~~ Notwithstanding any other provision of this paragraph, sell up to a maximum  
 12 of 5,000 barrels annually of such ~~beer~~ malt beverages manufactured on the licensed  
 13 premises to:

- 14 (i) Licensed licensed wholesale dealers for distribution to retailers and retail  
 15 consumption dealers;  
 16 (ii) The public for consumption off the premises pursuant to paragraph (4) of this  
 17 Code section; or  
 18 (iii) A combination thereof.

19 Under no circumstances shall such malt beverages be sold by a holder of a brewpub  
 20 license to any person holding a retail consumption dealer's license or a retailer's license  
 21 for the purpose of resale;"

22 "(4)(A) A brewpub license authorizes the holder of such license to permit an individual  
 23 to purchase and remove for consumption off the premises up to 64 ounces of malt  
 24 beverages manufactured on the premises of such brewpub, provided that such  
 25 individual has purchased and consumed a meal on the premises of the brewpub the  
 26 same calendar day as such individual purchases such malt beverages for consumption  
 27 off the premises. A dated receipt for the meal and any malt beverages purchased for  
 28 consumption off of the premises shall be provided by the licensee or an employee of  
 29 the licensee to the individual at the time of such purchase. No portion of the malt  
 30 beverages purchased for consumption off the premises of brewpub may be consumed  
 31 on the premises of the brewpub.

32 (B) Except as provided in subparagraph (A) of this paragraph, a brewpub license does  
33 not authorize the holder of such license to sell alcoholic beverages by the package for  
34 consumption off the premises;"
