## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Captain Jeremy Haynes; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Captain Jeremy Haynes was born on November 4, 1983, a beloved son of Joyce  
3 Ann Alexander and Jerome Haynes, Sr.; and

4 WHEREAS, he attended Early County Schools, Calhoun County Schools, and Dougherty  
5 County High School; he is a native of Arlington and Albany, Georgia, and received a  
6 commission into the quartermaster Corps through Georgia Military College (Early  
7 Commissioning Program, on May 27, 2004; and

8 WHEREAS, in May 2006, he graduated with cum laude honors from Fort Valley State  
9 University with a degree in history and also received his master's in management, with  
10 magna cum laude honors, from Florida Institute of Technology in 2013; and

11 WHEREAS, on August 5, 2014, while serving as an Aide-de-camp to Major General Harold  
12 Greene, a gunman opened fire on a group of coalition and Afghan Forces; with four life  
13 life-threatening wounds, Captain Haynes underwent multiple surgeries and continues his  
14 recovery; and

15 WHEREAS, Captain Haynes' notable prior assignments include Platoon Leader & Executive  
16 Officer, 421st Quartermaster Company (Riggers), US Army Reserves, Fort Valley, Georgia,  
17 Battalion Logistics Officer, 3rd Special Troops Battalion, 3rd Brigade, 101st Airborne  
18 Division (Air Assault), Commander 623rd Quartermaster Company (Riggers), 82nd  
19 Sustainment Brigade (Airborne), Training with industry, American Red Cross National  
20 Headquarters, Washington D.C., and Instructor at the United States Army Logistics  
21 University, Fort Lee, Virginia; and

22 WHEREAS, his most notable awards include the Purple Heart, Bronze Star Medal, Defense  
23 Meritorious Service Medal, Afghanistan Campaign Medal, Iraqi Freedom Campaign Medal,

24 Combat Action Medal, Senior Parachute Badge, Air Assault Badge, Parachute Rigger Badge,  
25 German Jump Wings, and the Norwegian 30K Road Mark Badge; and

26 WHEREAS, Captain Haynes is united in love and marriage and is blessed with six  
27 remarkable children; and

28 WHEREAS, he has the distinction of being honored at the 2015 Ceola Alexander Memorial  
29 Prayer Breakfast, a honor he aptly deserves for the service and sacrifice he has made for the  
30 State of Georgia and this country; and

31 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
32 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
