

House Bill 644 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act providing for a homestead exemption from all City of Warner Robins ad  
2 valorem taxes for any city purposes, including, but not limited to, taxes to retire bonded  
3 indebtedness for certain persons who have been residents of the City of Warner Robins for  
4 at least the immediately preceding five years and who are 65 years of age or older, approved  
5 April 5, 1995 (Ga. L. 1995, p. 4189), as amended, so as to change the date for filing an  
6 application for such homestead exemption; to provide for an effective date; to repeal  
7 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

10 An Act providing for a homestead exemption from all City of Warner Robins ad valorem  
11 taxes for any city purposes, including, but not limited to, taxes to retire bonded indebtedness  
12 for certain persons who have been residents of the City of Warner Robins for at least the  
13 immediately preceding five years and who are 65 years of age or older, approved April 5,  
14 1995 (Ga. L. 1995, p. 4189), as amended, is amended by revising Section 4 as follows:

15 "SECTION 4.

16 The exemption granted by this Act shall be claimed and returned as provided in Code  
17 Section 48-5-50.1 of the O.C.G.A., except that any applicant seeking an exemption under  
18 this Act shall file a written application therefor on or before April 1 of the year in which  
19 such exemption is sought in accordance with Code Sections 48-5-18 and 48-5-45 of the  
20 O.C.G.A."

21 **SECTION 2.**

22 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law  
23 without such approval.

**SECTION 3.**

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
