

House Bill 651 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act entitled "An Act to provide for the election of members of the board of
2 education of Paulding County," approved March 21, 1968 (Ga. L. 1968, p. 2381), as
3 amended, so as to change the method of filling vacancies on the board of education; to repeal
4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act entitled "An Act to provide for the election of members of the board of education of
8 Paulding County," approved March 21, 1968 (Ga. L. 1968, p. 2381), as amended, is amended
9 by revising Section 3 as follows:

10 "Section 3. (A) Any vacancy on the board which occurs with 180 or more days
11 remaining in the term of office at the time of the vacancy shall be filled by special
12 election for the remainder of the unexpired term of office. Upon the occurrence of the
13 vacancy the county school superintendent shall notify the county election superintendent
14 who shall call and conduct such special election as provided in Chapter 2 of Title 21 of
15 the O.C.G.A., the 'Georgia Election Code.'

16 (B) Any vacancy on the board which occurs with less than 180 days remaining in the
17 term of office shall be filled by the remaining members of the board appointing a
18 person to serve for the remainder of the unexpired term of office."

19 **SECTION 2.**

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
