## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Jake Carter for being recognized as a Champion of Change; and for other  
2 purposes.

4 Henry County is among a group of leaders from across the country who were recognized as  
5 Champions of Change for Agriculture in a ceremony at the White House; and
