A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 16-13-32.6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 manufacturing, distributing, dispensing, or possessing with intent to distribute controlled
3 substances or marijuana in, on, or within drug-free commercial zones, so as to change the
4 date of incorporation of local ordinances by reference; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
5 other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Code Section 16-13-32.6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
9 manufacturing, distributing, dispensing, or possessing with intent to distribute controlled
10 substances or marijuana in, on, or within drug-free commercial zones, is amended by revising
11 subsection (f) as follows:

12 "(f) The General Assembly hereby adopts and incorporates into this Code section all
13 drug-free commercial zones which have been adopted by municipal or county ordinance
14 and entered in the register of the Department of Community Affairs as provided for in
15 subsection (d) of this Code section on or before July 1, ~~2013~~ 2015."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
