A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Chapter 15 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
county law libraries, so as to revise the uses of excess funds by a county law library; to

3 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** 6 Chapter 15 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to county law 7 libraries, is amended by revising subsection (c) of Code Section 36-15-7, relating to use of 8 funds, as follows: 9 ''(c) In the event the board of trustees determines in its discretion that it has excess funds, 10 such funds as may be designated by the board of trustees shall be disbursed by the board 11 of trustees in either of the following manners: 12 (1) Granted granted to charitable tax exempt organizations which provide civil legal 13 representation for low-income people; or 14 (2) Used to purchase software, equipment, fixtures, or furnishings for the office of the 15 district attorney or solicitor-general or for county judicial facilities, including but not limited to courtrooms and jury rooms; provided, however, that the county commissioners 16 17 are given a copy of the receipts for such purchases. Any remaining excess funds shall may be turned over to the county commissioners, and 18 19 said funds upon being turned over, shall be used by the county commissioners for the 20 purchase of equipment, fixtures, and furnishings for the courthouse."
