- 7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and  
8 William has ably evidenced his aptitude and competency in mastering the various special  
9 skills taught through the Boy Scout program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man is a member of Troop 143 in Johns Creek where  
11 he served as Assistant Senior Patrol Leader and has demonstrated great leadership skills and  
12 initiative during his years with the Boy Scouts of America program; and
- 13 WHEREAS, for his Eagle Project, William led a team of his peers in modifying the  
14 Northview High School lacrosse practice field where he installed an artificial turf and  
15 drainage, added a memorial for the Northview High School 2014 Men's Lacrosse State  
16 Champions, repainted the lacrosse practice wall with the new Northview High School logo,  
17 raised \$5,595.00 for this project, and managed over 353 volunteer hours performed between  
18 planning and implementation; and
- 19 WHEREAS, William attended two BSA high adventures and Bahamas Sea Base and is  
20 serving as crew leader at Northern Tier; and
- 21 WHEREAS, William is a well-rounded student who is a varsity lacrosse player and is very  
22 active in his church, Johns Creek United Methodist; and

23 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader  
24 is a model for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
26 the members of this body commend William Roberson Webster for his diligence and  
27 dedication in pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and
