1 Recognizing and commending Alexandria Hartwig upon being honored with the Girl Scout
2 Gold Award; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Alexandria Hartwig, who attends River Ridge High School, has earned the
4 highest and most prestigious award in scouting, the Girl Scout Gold Award; and

5 WHEREAS, requirements for this award include leadership activities, a service project, and
6 the completion of a Gold Award project which must be sustainable and have a measurable
7 outcome; and

8 WHEREAS, Alexandria used all of her background skills, knowledge of the Girl Scout
9 program, and support and guidance from her troop advisers in order to complete her Gold
10 Award project, named the Bright Future Fund, and be honored with this prestigious award;

12 WHEREAS, the Bright Future Fund is a collective website of inexpensive or free summer
13 camps and activities that are available in her local community; and

14 WHEREAS, Alexandria hopes that the Bright Future Fund will educate the local community
15 on all available summer events and camps and the importance of keeping kids supervised and
16 stimulated during the summer so as to deter them from experimenting with crime and drugs,
17 as the rates of such events are higher in the summer; and

18 WHEREAS, she has displayed outstanding integrity, honesty, and leadership, and she is a
19 positive role model for other young women in the Girl Scouts and throughout this state; and

20 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
21 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young woman's future.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
23 the members of this body commend Alexandria Hartwig for her diligence and dedication in
24 pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Girl Scouts of America and congratulate her on
