8 dramatically by his superlative service with Polk County Emergency Medical Services; and

18 WHEREAS, Curtis Vincent has been a historical component in the entire inception of
19 emergency medical care, serving as the past director of Polk County Emergency Medical
20 Services and the District Commander for Redmond Regional Medical Center's Emergency
21 Medical Services in Polk County; and

22 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
23 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
25 the members of this body commend Curtis Vincent for his efficient, effective, unselfish, and
26 dedicated public service to the State of Georgia; congratulate him upon the grand occasion
