A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Satilla District on being named the Georgia Forestry
2 Commission 2015 District of the Year; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the mission of the Georgia Forestry Commission is to provide leadership,
4 service and education in the protection and conservation of Georgia's forest resources; and

5 WHEREAS, each year one Forestry District is selected as Georgia Forestry Commission's
6 District of the Year based on measures of accomplishments that include customer
7 satisfaction, public outreach, number of miles of firebreaks plowed and harrowed, acres of
8 prescribed burning accomplished, training hours logged, equipment and facility appearance,
9 tree seedlings sold, and landowner forest management plans completed; and

10 WHEREAS, due to these outstanding accomplishments of the Satilla District in the year
11 2015, the District was selected as Georgia Forestry Commission's District of the Year; and

12 WHEREAS, the accomplishments of the Satilla District are a clear indication of the hard
13 work, dedication, and teamwork present in the District, the ability of District personnel to
14 meet increased demand for services by working together with fewer resources, and their
15 continual loyalty to landowners, citizens, and communities; and

17 professionals within the District, the citizens of the District, the Georgia Forestry
18 Commission, and the State of Georgia.
