A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Ms. Triana Arnold James and friends' advocacy to expand Medicaid and raise
2 awareness for cervical cancer in Georgia; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, there are still approximately 300,000 Georgians without health insurance; and

4 WHEREAS, Medicaid expansion in Georgia would offer Georgians access to health
5 insurance that they cannot currently afford; and

6 WHEREAS, Triana Arnold James, a delegate for the State of Georgia for the 2015-2016
7 Mrs. Georgia of Today's American Woman program, has used her stature to advocate for the
8 well-being of all uninsured Georgians; and

9 WHEREAS, this group has furthered the cause of expanding Medicaid for uninsured
