A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Scott Ford Davis; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Scott Ford Davis, who attends Lassiter High School and plans on attending the
3 University of Georgia, has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the most distinguished rank
4 conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 5 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
6 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
7 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 8 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and Scott
9 has ably evidenced his aptitude and competency in mastering the various special skills taught
10 through the Boy Scout program; and
- 11 WHEREAS, to become an Eagle Scout, Scott led the refresh of a school courtyard at
12 Freedom Middle School in Cherokee County, Georgia, where his team fixed a drainage
13 problem in five unfinished patches in the courtyard, replaced mulch, and planted flowering
14 plants and shrubs, making the courtyard more useful for the school; and
- 15 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man is a member of Troop 714 in Marietta, Georgia,
16 and has demonstrated great leadership skills and initiative during his years with the Boy
17 Scouts of America program; and
- 18 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Scott has truly exhibited a commitment to the
19 scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a
20 manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and
- 21 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
22 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
24 the members of this body commend Scott Ford Davis for his diligence and dedication in
25 pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on
26 attaining the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
