A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Councilman Warren Hadlock; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Councilman Warren Hadlock was born in Atlanta, Georgia, has resided in
3 Clarkston for 20 years, and is a flooring installation contractor; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Councilman Hadlock was elected to the Clarkston City Council in 2008 and has
5 served on the Planning and Development Board and the Zoning and Review Board; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he is a volunteer for Rivers Alive Clean Up and a volunteer caretaker for
7 Friendship Forest; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Councilman Hadlock has been at the forefront of supporting and spearheading
9 projects that bring people together, including his assistance in the construction of Clarkston's
10 Dog Park, the \$500,000.00 he obtained for the new swimming pool complex, his successful
11 efforts in the creation of the Master Plan for Friendship Forest Wildlife Sanctuary, his
12 support for citizen-initiated projects, such as a senior citizen program and the wildflower
13 gardens in the city, his leadership in implementing and achieving Mayor Ted's idea for the
14 right of citizens to participate in the budget process, and his voting to successfully lower
15 property taxes for 2016; and
- 16 WHEREAS, his personal motto is "gutto cavit lapidem (non vi sed saepe cadendo)," which
17 means "water makes a hole in a rock not by force but by persistence"; and
- 18 WHEREAS, he believes that "being a successful City Council member is all about building
19 a community where people come together to work, play, and worship in a safe, affordable
20 environment in which everyone feels respected"; and
- 21 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
22 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
