1 Honoring the life and memory of Charles "Brownie" Winfred Pittman, Sr.; and for other
2 purposes.

4 with the passing of Charles "Brownie" Winfred Pittman, Sr., on December 26, 2015; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Pittman was born on December 30, 1930, in McCaysville, Georgia, a
6 beloved son of Claude and Dueane Della Beavers Pittman; and

14 Williamstown United Methodist Church; and

15 WHEREAS, Mr. Pittman was united in love and marriage to Mary Nell Woodall Pittman,
16 and was blessed with sons and daughters-in-law, Charles and Melissa Pittman and Jon and
17 Patti Pittman; daughter and son-in-law, Jennifer and Rick Hudson, seven wonderful
18 grandchildren, Zach, Brett, Ryan, April, Chris, Matt, and Amanda; and 16 amazing
19 great-grandchildren; and

20 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
21 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
22 family and friends were admired by others; and

23 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
24 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example he made of his life, he
25 made this world a better place in which to live; and

26 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Mr. Pittman will long be remembered for
27 his love of family and friendship, and this loyal husband, father, grandfather,
28 great-grandfather, and friend will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.
