13 family and friends were admired by others; and
- 14 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Mr. Holloway was an active member of Blue
15 Ridge United Methodist Church; and
- 16 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to Doris Pittman Holloway and was blessed
17 with three remarkable children, Anthony, Tracy, and Jeffrey, and five wonderful
18 grandchildren, Avery, Will, Anna, Carlee, and Lindsey; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Mr. Holloway was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable
20 reputation for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of
21 his life, he made this world a better place in which to live; and

23 of family and friendship, and this loyal gentleman and friend will be missed by all who had
24 the great fortune of knowing him.
