A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Planned PEThood of Georgia; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the mission of Planned PEThood is to help pets and the people who care for
3 them by providing innovative programs and affordable services that save lives; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Planned PEThood provides high-quality, high-volume, low-cost surgeries for
5 dogs and cats to prevent unwanted litters and affordable monthly walk-in clinics that provide
6 exams and vaccines to keep pets healthy; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Planned PEThood places homeless pets with foster families and gives the pets
8 premium health care and socialization before finding them permanent homes; on average,
9 this organization rescues and finds homes for 600 animals per year; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Planned PEThood is led by a Board of Directors, and employs a full-time staff,
11 including an executive director, medical director, clinic operations manager, and veterinary
12 assistants, plus more than 50 volunteers, who care for animals, hold weekly adoption events,
13 assist at monthly clinics, and raise funds.
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
15 the members of this body recognize and commend Planned PEThood for the outstanding
16 services it provides to the State of Georgia.
- 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
18 and directed to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to
19 Planned PEThood.
