- 3 WHEREAS, Lambda Theta Phi Latin Fraternity, Inc., also known as "The Lambdas," has six

- 13 WHEREAS, Lambda Theta Phi Latin Fraternity, Inc., provides their members with the

- while instilling in them the values of unity, respect, brotherhood, culture, and pride, as well
- as the professionalism and work ethic needed to be successful in their future careers; and

- 18 education of their campus communities through informational events and seminars on
- 19 relevant social topics, give back to their communities through local philanthropic and
- 20 mentoring efforts, raise funds for the Congressional Hispanic Caucus Institute as well as
- 21 local charities, and engage in social events with other fraternities, sororities, and campus
- 22 groups; and
- 23 WHEREAS, The Lambdas at the state-wide level volunteer and create partnerships with
- 24 social service groups such as the Latin American Association, the Georgia Association of
