19 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
20 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young woman's future.

22 the members of this body commend Emma Denning for her diligence and dedication in
23 pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Girl Scouts of America and congratulate her on
