A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 10 of Chapter 21 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
2 relating to the Georgia Driver's Education Commission, so as to transfer such commission
3 from the Department of Driver Services to the Governor's Office of Highway Safety; to
4 extend the sunset applicable to penalties for violations of traffic laws or ordinances; to
5 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Article 10 of Chapter 21 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
9 the Georgia Driver's Education Commission, is amended by revising Code Section
10 15-21-172, relating to the establishment of such commission, as follows:

11 "15-21-172.

12 There is established the Georgia Driver's Education Commission, which is assigned to the
13 ~~Department of Driver Services~~ Governor's Office of Highway Safety for administrative
14 purposes only, as prescribed in Code Section 50-4-3."

15 **SECTION 2.**

16 Said article is further amended in Code Section 15-21-179, relating to additional penalty for
17 violation of traffic laws or ordinances, by revising subsection (c) as follows:

18 "(c) This Code section shall be repealed in its entirety on ~~June 30, 2016~~ June 30, 2019,
19 unless extended by an Act of the General Assembly."

20 **SECTION 3.**

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
