A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Part 15 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia  
2 Annotated, relating to miscellaneous provisions under the "Quality Basic Education Act,"  
3 so as to provide for unique identifiers for students of military personnel; to provide a short  
4 title; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Educating Children of Military Families  
8 Act."

9 **SECTION 2.**

10 Part 15 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,  
11 relating to miscellaneous provisions under the "Quality Basic Education Act," is amended  
12 by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

13 "20-2-324.2.

14 The Department of Education is authorized to establish a unique identifier for each student:

15 (1) Whose parent or guardian is an active duty military service member in the armed  
16 forces of the United States; and

17 (2) Whose parent is a member of a reserve component of the armed forces of the United  
18 States or the National Guard

19 in a manner that will allow for disaggregation of data for each category."

20 **SECTION 3.**

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
