## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Mr. Terry Wayne Grindle; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens  
3 with the passing of Mr. Terry Wayne Grindle on November 28, 2015; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Grindle was born on November 10, 1947, in Lumpkin County, a beloved  
5 son of Mr. L.D. Grindle and Mrs. Lucille Clark Grindle; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United  
7 States Army, valiantly and courageously protecting his fellow Americans during the Vietnam  
8 War; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Mr. Grindle had a strong desire to serve his community, and help it grow and  
10 prosper, which is demonstrated by his involvement in establishing the Public Defender  
11 System for the Enotah Judicial Circuit and his persistence in securing grants for the first  
12 computers for the Lumpkin County School System; and
- 13 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to Mrs. Wylene Ravan Grindle, and was  
14 blessed with one remarkable son, Brian, and two wonderful grandchildren, Seth and Aaron;

- 16 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern  
17 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his  
18 family and friends were admired by others; and
- 19 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
20 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example he made of his life, he  
21 made this world a better place in which to live; and

22 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Mr. Grindle will long be remembered for  
23 his love of family and friendship, and this loyal husband, father, and friend will be missed  
24 by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.
