A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Superior Court Judge Quillian Baldwin on the occasion of his
2 retirement; and for other purposes.

4 role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the welfare of the
5 citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
7 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced
8 dramatically by his service as a 1st Lieutenant in the United States Army, a Juvenile Court
9 Judge in Troup County, the Chief Judge of the Superior Court for the Coweta Judicial

11 Judiciary Committee from 1991-1992 and the Assistant Floor Leader for Governor Joe Frank

19 which is evidenced by his involvement in the First United Methodist Church where he serves
20 as the Chairman of the Administrative Board and on numerous other committees; and

21 WHEREAS, he is united in love and marriage to Judith Parker Baldwin, and has three
22 remarkable children, Trey, Lei, and Wade; and

23 WHEREAS, Judge Baldwin has served with honor and distinction, his vision and unyielding
24 commitment have set the standard for public service, and he will be sorely missed upon the
25 occasion of his retirement; and

26 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
27 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
