## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to elections, so as to
- 2 prohibit persons employed within the executive branch of state government from registering
- 3 and acting as a lobbyist and from being hired as a consultant by any agency or entity of the
- 4 executive branch of state government for a period of one year following the termination of
- 5 such person's employment with the executive branch of state government; to provide for
- 6 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to elections, is amended by
- adding a new Code section to Article 4 of Chapter 5, relating to public officials' conduct and
- 11 lobbyist disclosure, to read as follows:
- 12 "<u>21-5-77.</u>
- 13 (a) Employees of the executive branch of state government shall be prohibited from
- registering as a lobbyist or engaging in lobbying under this article for a period of one year
- after terminating such employment.
- 16 (b) Employees of the executive branch of state government shall be prohibited from being
- 17 <u>hired or contracting as a consultant with any agency or entity of the executive branch of</u>
- 18 state government for a period of one year after terminating such employment."

19 **SECTION 2.** 

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
