## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from sales and use tax, so as to provide a new exemption from state sales and use tax for a limited period of time regarding property used in renovation and rehabilitation of affordable housing; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

## 7 **SECTION 1.** 8 Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from 9 sales and use tax, is amended by deleting "or" at the end of paragraph (95), by deleting the 10 period and adding "; or" at the end of paragraph (96), and by adding a new paragraph to read 11 as follows: 12 "(97) For the period commencing on July 1, 2016, and ending on June 30, 2018, sales of 13 tangible personal property used in direct connection with the construction, renovation, 14 and rehabilitation of affordable housing by an organization which is exempt from taxation 15 under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and is recognized as a bona fide nonprofit organization by the Georgia Department of Revenue." 16 17 **SECTION 2.** 18 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2016.

- 20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
