A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Article 2 of Chapter 20 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
relating to leaves of absence for certain public employees, so as to provide paid leave upon

3 the death of an immediate family member; to provide for related matters; to repeal4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- **SECTION 1.** 6 7 Article 2 of Chapter 20 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 8 leaves of absence for certain public employees, is amended by adding a new Code section 9 to read as follows: 10 ″<u>45-20-33.</u> 11 (a) For purposes of this Code section, the term 'immediate family' means the employee's 12 spouse or a parent, legal guardian, grandparent, great-grandparent, sibling, brother-in-law, 13 sister-in-law, child, stepchild, grandchild, or great-grandchild of the employee or the 14 employee's spouse. 15 (b) Each employee of the State of Georgia or of any branch, department, board, bureau, 16 or commission of the State of Georgia shall receive a leave of absence, with pay, of three consecutive work days upon the death of any member of such employee's immediate 17 family. The employee shall not be entitled to such leave of absence with pay unless he or 18 19 she furnishes to his or her supervisor or other proper authority a statement providing the 20 name and relationship of the deceased."
