A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Westminster Schools' varsity football team; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Westminster Schools' varsity football team, located in Atlanta, Georgia,
4 ended an historic 11-4 season, securing the 2015 Class AAA State Championship; and

5 WHEREAS, the team was supported by the strong leadership of Head Coach Gerry
6 Romberg, the winningest head football coach in the history of Westminster, compiling a
7 record of 180-103, with 19 seasons in the state playoffs, 17 winning seasons, two trips to the
8 state semifinals, and now a State Championship; and

9 WHEREAS, Westminster's Assistant Coaches included T.J. Anderson, James Collis, James
10 Falcetti, Sean O'Sullivan, John Wild, and Thomas Wrenn; and

11 WHEREAS, also leading the team were the 2015 varsity football team captains, Cage
12 Reeder, Tyler Gillikin, Chase Williams, Blake Huber, and Keller Harper, who each exhibited
13 outstanding dedication and perseverance; and

14 WHEREAS, the team won an unprecedented eight away games in a row, including all five
15 playoff games; and

16 WHEREAS, the team made it to the semifinals in 2014 and 1996, and won their last state
17 title in 1978.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 recognize and commend the Westminster Schools' varsity football team for winning the 2015
20 Class AAA State Championship and express their most sincere best wishes for continued
21 success.
