A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Ms. Rose Strong and congratulating her on her 70th birthday; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, on January 20, 1946, Rose was born in Minden, Louisiana; there she grew up
4 with her parents, Anthony and Carrie Roe, and 12 siblings and attended Webster Parish
5 Public Schools; and

6 WHEREAS, in 1967, she obtained her degree in political science from Southern University
7 in Baton Rouge, Louisiana; and

8 WHEREAS, committed to helping the community, Ms. Strong served as a City
9 Councilwoman in Columbus, Georgia, political appointee under President Bush, lobbyist,
10 and political consultant and currently serves as vice president and spokesperson for T.E.C.H.
11 for the World, Incorporated; and

12 WHEREAS, a pioneer, she is known and recognized for her leadership and as the first black
13 woman elected in Muscogee County; and

14 WHEREAS, a woman of deep and abiding faith, she is an active and integral member of the
15 City Church; and

16 WHEREAS, Rose is blessed with two remarkable children, Roz and Mack, Jr., and two
17 wonderful grandchildren, Isaiah Anthony and Evan James; and

18 WHEREAS, she loves God, her country, family, and friends; and

19 WHEREAS, it is fitting to set aside time and recognize the efforts of Ms. Rose Strong in
20 Georgia over the last 70 years.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
22 commend Ms. Rose Strong on her many contributions to our country and state, congratulate
23 her upon the grand occasion of her 70th birthday, and extend to her their most sincere best
