1 Recognizing and commending Peyton Ledford upon being honored with the Girl Scout Gold
2 Award; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Peyton Ledford has earned the highest and most prestigious award in Girl
4 Scouting, the Girl Scout Gold Award; and

5 WHEREAS, requirements for this award include leadership activities, a service project, and
6 the completion of a Gold Award project which must be sustainable and have a measurable
7 outcome; and

8 WHEREAS, volunteering 73 hours to raise awareness for dementia patients, Peyton
9 established and led a team of over 15 professionals, peers, and family, raised \$436 and
10 donated games and crafts to Memory Care Centers around the country, reached more than
11 1,000 people through education and involvement, created a program where youth adopt
12 dementia patients and interact with them, and engaged local youth clubs to sustain the
13 project; and

14 WHEREAS, Peyton used all her background skills, knowledge of the Girl Scout program,
15 and support and guidance from her troop advisors in order to complete her Gold Award
16 project and be honored with this prestigious award; and

17 WHEREAS, she has displayed outstanding integrity, honesty, and leadership, and she is a
18 positive role model for other young women in the Girl Scouts and throughout this state; and

19 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
20 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young woman's future.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
22 the members of this body commend Peyton Ledford for her diligence and dedication in

23 pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Girl Scouts of America and congratulate her on
24 earning the Girl Scout Gold Award.
