## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending John Huie for his 2015 Non-Performer Award and induction  
2 into the Georgia Music Hall of Fame; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, John Huie was born in Macon, Georgia, and is a powerful force behind the  
4 scenes of the music industry, starting his career at the Paragon Agency; and

5 WHEREAS, he later launched Frontier Booking International, which was instrumental in  
6 helping artists such as The Police, R.E.M., The Go-Go's, and Joan Jett break through in the  
7 music industry; and

8 WHEREAS, he remains today at Creative Artists Agency, where he has become one of the  
9 premier top agents in Nashville, Tennessee, and has grown their company from two  
10 employees to more than 70 employees; and

11 WHEREAS, as co-leader of the Creative Artists Agency, John Huie has worked with clients  
12 such as Faith Hill, Jennifer Nettles, Zac Brown Band, Alan Jackson, Lady Antebellum, and  
13 more; and

14 WHEREAS, in 1999, John Huie won a Grammy Award in the Country/Bluegrass/Gospel  
15 Album of the Year category for his participation as a producer of the soundtrack to the film,  
16 *The Apostle*; and

17 WHEREAS, John Huie's importance to the music industry may not be on the stage or in the  
18 recording studio but has been uncovering and leading many of the great musical talents to  
19 astounding success and accomplishments.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
21 commend John Huie for his decades of work behind the scenes of the music industry and

22 recognize his 2015 Non-Performer Award and induction into the Georgia Music Hall of  
23 Fame.
