A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending the Georgia Public Policy Foundation for its 25th year of
2 continued service and work in researching and analyzing state public policy issues to educate
3 citizens and enhance economic opportunity; and for other purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, the Georgia Public Policy Foundation hosts dozens of events each year,
5 facilitating discussions between state members and political, education, media, and business
6 leaders; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the Georgia Public Policy Foundation has conducted scholarly research and
8 analysis of state public policy issues and worked to educate citizens, policymakers, and the
9 media since 1991; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the Georgia Public Policy Foundation maintains a state focused, independent,
11 nonpartisan and market oriented approach to improve the lives of Georgians; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the Georgia Public Policy Foundation has many opportunities for advocacy,
13 membership, and volunteering; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the Georgia Public Policy Foundation works with policy on education, the
15 environment, criminal justice, government reform, health care, legal reform, regulation,
16 spending, taxes, transportation, and welfare reform; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the Georgia Public Policy Foundation's members donate to the Student
18 Outreach Scholarship Program, providing assistance for lower income students to attend
19 college and learn about public policy issues; and
- 20 WHEREAS, the Georgia Senate and the Georgia House of Representatives, as part-time
21 legislators, benefit greatly from the research and analysis of the Georgia Public Policy
22 Foundation.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
24 recognize and commend the Georgia Public Policy Foundation for its continued service in
25 public policy for the betterment of Georgia over the past 25 years and express their most
26 sincere gratitude for its efforts.
