## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the Georgia East Metro Health District Medical Reserve Corps, Inc.; and for

- 3 WHEREAS, the Medical Reserve Corps is a national network of trained volunteers, 4 organized locally to improve the health and safety of their communities by responding to 5 natural disasters and other emergencies; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Georgia has 18 units statewide with total membership of approximately 3,7007 people; and

8 WHEREAS, during the 2015 fiscal year, Georgia Medical Reserve Corps members 9 volunteered nearly 7,000 hours statewide, producing an economic value estimated to be over 10 \$170,000; and

- WHEREAS, the Georgia East Metro Health District Medical Reserve Corps, Inc., a unit of the Medical Reserve Corps that serves the health and emergency preparedness needs of Georgia's Gwinnett, Newton, and Rockdale counties, currently has nearly 400 members, who volunteer over 3,000 hours per year, producing an estimated economic value of nearly \$75,000; and
- WHEREAS, this selfless display of volunteerism in assisting those in need during time ofcrisis demonstrates the noble spirit of Georgians and is most deserving of recognition.
