A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Mr. David Hong for his extraordinary efforts in civic
2 engagement; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. David Hong's belief that "more people should get active in civic affairs and
4 take pride in their community" is epitomized in his efforts, since 1979, in acting as
5 community advocate in solving local zoning issues and later founding the East Cobb Civic
6 Association, where he has served in every position within the organization and is currently
7 serving as the second vice president, head of the transportation committee and is also a
8 member of the zoning and variance committee; and

9 WHEREAS, he has made many contributions to his community, including serving on the
10 Comprehensive Land Use Advisory Board, One Percent Sales Tax Citizen Oversight
11 Committee, Alternate Funding Committee, Open Space Community Zoning District
12 Advisory Committee, Livable Communities Coalition, and the Georgia Department of
13 Transportation's Citizen Advisory Committee; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Hong also served on the Transit Advisory Board and the 2011 Johnson
15 Ferry Urban Design Plan steering committee; and

16 WHEREAS, he has made a lasting contribution to Metro Atlanta by also serving on the
17 Atlanta Regional Commission board and various committees, including the Livable Centers
18 Initiative, Land Use Coordinating Committee, Regional Development Plan, and the Fifty
19 Forward Steering Committee; and

20 WHEREAS, the Cobb County Board of Commissioners extends its heartfelt thanks to Mr.
21 David Hong for all of the time, work, and effort he has put into helping improve its
22 community and for the pride and dedication to civic duty he has shown through his words
23 and actions; and

24 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
25 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
