A RESOLUTION

- 1 Urging local boards of education to avoid scheduling any high school graduation or
- 2 matriculation ceremonies or commencements on the same day that the general primary
- 3 election is held; and for other purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, high school graduation ceremonies and commencements are important
- 5 occasions for the students completing high school requirements and their families and
- 6 friends; and
- 7 WHEREAS, elections for state and local government representatives are likewise a very
- 8 important part of our country's fabric and one of the basic rights of an American; and
- 9 WHEREAS, many times, election polling places are located at local schools in the area,
- 10 including high schools; and
- WHEREAS, high school graduations are commonly scheduled in the month of May; and
- 12 WHEREAS, as of 2014, Georgia's primary election is also held in the month of May; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the scheduling of high school graduation ceremonies and commencements on
- 14 the same day as the general primary election could result in voter suppression.
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 16 the members of this body urge local boards of education to avoid scheduling any high school
- 17 graduation or matriculation ceremonies or commencements on the same day that the general
- 18 primary election is held.
- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to local
- 21 boards of education.
