- 1 Honoring the life of Sergeant First Class Victor A. Anderson and dedicating a road in his
- 2 memory; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, our nation's security continues to rely on patriotic men and women who put
- 4 their personal lives on hold in order to place themselves in harm's way to protect the
- 5 freedoms that all United States citizens cherish; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Sergeant First Class Victor A. Anderson demonstrated a deep personal
- 7 commitment to protecting democracy and a willingness to sacrifice his own personal safety
- 8 and comfort to ensure the well-being of his fellow man; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United
- 10 States Army and Army National Guard for 22 years and was killed in action while serving
- 11 in Iraq; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Sergeant First Class Anderson's commendations include the Bronze Star, Purple
- 13 Heart, Combat Infantryman's Badge, Army Commendation Medal, Army Achievement
- 14 Medal, Army Good Conduct Medal, Army Reserve Component Achievement Medal,
- 15 National Defense Service Medal, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Southwest Asia
- 16 Service Medal, Iraqi Campaign Medal, Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal,
- 17 Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Armed Forces Service Medal, Armed Forces
- 18 Reserve Medal, NCO Professional Development Ribbon, Army Service Ribbon, Army
- 19 Overseas Service Ribbon, United Nations Medal, NATO Medal-Former Republic of
- 20 Yugoslavia, Kuwait Liberation Medal-Saudi Arabia, Kuwait Liberation Medal-Kuwait,
- 21 Georgia Special Operations Ribbon, and Georgia State Active Duty Ribbon; and
- 22 WHEREAS, he served as a police officer and deputy sheriff in his hometown of Ellaville and
- as a deputy sheriff in Sumter County; and

24 WHEREAS, Sergeant First Class Anderson embodied the spirit of service, willing to find

- 25 meaning in something greater than himself, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that this
- 26 remarkable and distinguished American be recognized appropriately by dedicating a road in
- 27 his memory.
- 28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
- 29 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of Highway 19 from Schley County mile
- 30 marker 0 to Sumter County mile marker 15.7 and continuing to the northern city limits of
- 31 Americus at mile marker 14 is dedicated as the SFC Victor A. Anderson Memorial Highway.
- 32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
- 33 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the SFC Victor A. Anderson
- 34 Memorial Highway.
- 35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 36 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 37 family of Sergeant First Class Victor A. Anderson and to the Department of Transportation.
