## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the Emory Scholars Program; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Emory Scholars Program was founded by Robert W. Woodruff to attract  
3 true scholars and community partners to Emory; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the Emory Scholars Program focuses on finding individuals with outstanding  
5 academic success who are grounded in the qualities of intellectual curiosity, creative  
6 thinking, servant leadership, communication skills, and contribution to community; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Emory Scholars give their time, energy, and talents to better their lives and the  
8 lives of others by actively participating in the Emory and Georgia communities; and
- 9 WHEREAS, there are 180 Emory Scholars at Emory College, including a number of  
10 signature Robert W. Woodruff Scholars; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the Emory Scholars represent 29 different states and 13 different countries; and
- 12 WHEREAS, fifty-five Emory Scholars come from the State of Georgia.
- 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
14 the members of this body recognize the Emory Scholars Program for the leadership and  
15 generosity of its members.
- 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
17 and directed to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to the  
18 Emory Scholars Program.
