A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Mr. Scott Woerner upon his induction into the College
2 Football Hall of Fame; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Scott Woerner was a four-sport letterman at Jonesboro High School in
4 Jonesboro, Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, he played football at the University of Georgia, was an integral player in the
6 Sugar Bowl win and National Champion title in 1980, and was named a consensus All-SEC
7 and All-American; and

8 WHEREAS, he is the 13th player from the University of Georgia to be inducted into the
9 College Football Hall of Fame; and

10 WHEREAS, he played in both the NFL and the USFL, winning two national championships
11 and being named the All-League Player while playing for the USFL; and

12 WHEREAS, he is a member of the Georgia Sports Hall of Fame and 2016 inductee into the
13 College Football Hall of Fame; and

14 WHEREAS, he has spent 26 years as an educator teaching science and physical education
15 courses to students from elementary to high school; and

16 WHEREAS, he currently teaches in Habersham County and serves as an inspiration and
17 mentor for children to follow their dreams and to succeed.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
19 the members of this body recognize and commend Mr. Scott Woerner upon his induction into
20 the College Football Hall of Fame.
