A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the Georgia Athletic Trainers' Association; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Georgia Athletic Trainers' Association (GATA) was created in the 1980s
3 as an organization committed to the education of its members and the enhancement of the
4 profession of athletic training, creating better health care for the population it serves; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the GATA is composed of over 1,000 licensed athletic trainers from
6 professional, collegiate, and high school teams; industries; physician offices; and
7 rehabilitation clinics working together to promote and practice the profession of athletic
8 training within the State of Georgia; and
- 9 WHEREAS, athletic trainers are health care professionals who collaborate with physicians
10 to optimize patient and client activity and participation in athletics, work, and life; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the practice of athletic training encompasses the prevention, examination and
12 diagnosis, treatment, and rehabilitation of emergent, acute, subacute, and chronic
13 neuromusculoskeletal and certain medical conditions to minimize subsequent impairments,
14 functional limitations, disability, and societal limitations.
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
16 recognize the Georgia Athletic Trainers' Association for their honorable work in keeping the
17 community healthy.
- 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
19 to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to the Georgia
20 Athletic Trainers' Association.
