A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To abolish the office of elected county surveyor of Whitfield County; to provide for the
- 2 appointment of a county surveyor by the governing authority of the county; to provide that
- 3 the person currently serving as elected county surveyor shall serve the remainder of his or
- 4 her term; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting
- 5 laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Pursuant to the authority granted by Code Section 36-7-2.1 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 9 Annotated, the office of elected county surveyor of Whitfield County is abolished. The
- 10 governing authority of Whitfield County shall appoint a qualified person to hold the office
- of county surveyor for a term of one year from the date of appointment. Successors shall
- 12 also be appointed for terms of one year. Any person appointed county surveyor shall possess
- the qualifications specified by paragraph (1) of subsection (b) of Code Section 36-7-2 of the
- 14 Official Code of Georgia Annotated. The person serving as elected county surveyor of
- 15 Whitfield County on January 1, 2016, shall continue to serve as such until the expiration of
- 16 the current term to which such person was elected.

SECTION 2.

- 18 This Act shall become law upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 19 without such approval.

SECTION 3.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
