A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Ms. Julianna Spradlin; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Ms. Julianna Spradlin is the first Gordon Lee Memorial High School volleyball
3 player to earn an athletic scholarship and will attend Truett-McConnell College in Cleveland,
4 Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, as a high school player, Ms. Spradlin earned four volleyball athletic letters and
6 is the first volleyball player in the school's history to be named to an All-State team; and

7 WHEREAS, as a starter for three of her four years, Ms. Spradlin led her team to 30
8 back-to-back winning seasons, two undefeated 7-AA Area Championships, and two Class
9 AA Elite Eight state playoff appearances; and

10 WHEREAS, Ms. Spradlin held the highest hitting percentage in all of Class AA and was
11 voted 7-AA All-Area First team and Walker County, Georgia, Player of the Year as both a
12 junior and senior; and

13 WHEREAS, in 2014, she was one of only six players in the United States to receive the
14 National Collegiate Scout Association "Athleader" award for her excellence in academics,
15 athletics, and community leadership; and

16 WHEREAS, she has excelled both on and off the volleyball court, maintaining a 4.0 grade
17 point average; and

18 WHEREAS, Ms. Spradlin has used her role as a volleyball player to be an inspiring leader
19 not only for her volleyball team but also for her school and the Walker County community.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
21 recognize Ms. Julianna Spradlin for her outstanding commitment to her volleyball team, for

22 her academic accomplishments, and for receiving the first volleyball scholarship in her
23 school's history.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
