A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 6 of Title 32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to dimensions and weight of vehicles and loads, so as to provide for the issuance of
- 3 an annual commercial wrecker tow permit; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 2 of Chapter 6 of Title 32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 dimensions and weight of vehicles and loads, is amended in Code Section 32-6-28, relating
- 9 to permits for excess weight and dimensions, by revising paragraph (3) of subsection (b) as
- 10 follows:

- 11 "(3) Annual commercial wrecker emergency tow permit. Pursuant to this Code
- section, the commissioner may issue an annual permit for vehicles towing disabled,
- damaged, abandoned, <u>replacement</u>, or wrecked commercial vehicles, including
- 14 combination vehicles, even though such wrecker or its load exceeds the maximum limits
- specified in this article. For purposes of this paragraph, the term 'replacement' shall be
- limited to a commercial vehicle that is towed to the location of a disabled, damaged, or
- 17 <u>wrecked commercial vehicle and that has a similar weight and dimension of such</u>
- disabled, damaged, or wrecked vehicle. An annual commercial wrecker emergency tow
- 19 permit shall not authorize the operation of a vehicle:
- 20 (A) Whose single axle weight exceeds 25,000 pounds;
- 21 (B) Whose load on one tandem axle exceeds 50,000 pounds and whose load on any
- secondary tandem axle exceeds 38,000 pounds; or
- 23 (C) Whose total load length exceeds 125 feet."

SECTION 2.

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
