A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Mr. Steven Charles Brack and dedicating a bridge in his memory; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia continues to mourn the loss of one of its most distinguished
4 citizens with the passing of Mr. Steven Charles Brack on October 11, 2004; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Brack served with the Allentown Volunteer Fire Department and was a
6 member of the Allentown City Council; and

7 WHEREAS, his life was tragically cut short when he was involved in a vehicle crash while
8 responding to a call on Interstate 16; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Brack gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep
10 concern for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he
11 demonstrated to his family and friends were admired by others; and

12 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
13 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example he made of his life, he
14 made this world a better place in which to live; and

15 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
16 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating a bridge in his memory.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
18 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the bridge on Highway 112 over Interstate 16 in Wilkinson
19 County is dedicated as the Steven Charles Brack Memorial Bridge.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
21 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Steven Charles Brack
22 Memorial Bridge.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
24 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
25 family of Mr. Steven Charles Brack and to the Department of Transportation.
