A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Ms. Eloise Scott Archibald; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, daughter of Ezell and Catherine Scott and the eldest of four siblings, Ms. Eloise
3 Scott Archibald, a native of Warrenton, Georgia, who has lived in Clayton County for the
4 past 30 years, is the proud mother of Preston David Archibald; and

5 WHEREAS, Ms. Archibald retired on September 30, 2014, as Senior Administrative
6 Accounting Analyst from Munich American Reassurance Company after 40 years of service;

8 WHEREAS, her motto, "If I can help one person then my living would not be in vain," is
9 embodied in her many years of community service and dedication to the citizens of Clayton
10 County, having served with the Clayton County NAACP as the Freedom Fund chair,
11 membership chair, and secretary; on the Clayton County Youth Council; with the Clayton
12 County Martin Luther King, Jr., Parade Committee as secretary; with the Stockbridge
13 District Number 17 Order of the Eastern Star as District Matron; and with the Smooth Ashlar
14 Grand Chapter Order of Eastern Star; and

15 WHEREAS, with the Smooth Ashlar Grand Chapter Order of Eastern Star, Ms. Archibald
16 donated 40,000 bars of Dial soap to the Family Unification Network, Inc., which supports
17 women and men incarcerated in prisons throughout the State of Georgia; and

18 WHEREAS, under the leadership of Ms. Archibald, the Stockbridge District 17 Order of the
19 Eastern Star has donated school supplies, clothing, toys, and food to Clayton County
20 disadvantaged families during the holiday seasons; and

21 WHEREAS, a woman of deep and abiding faith, Ms. Archibald is an active member of New
22 Macedonia Baptist Church in Riverdale, and her love of Jesus fuels her devotion and
23 commitment to helping those less fortunate; and

24 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
25 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
27 the members of this body commend Ms. Eloise Scott Archibald for her unselfish and
28 dedicated public service to her community.
