- 14 efficient, effective delivery of pre-hospital emergency medical care; transportation to the
- most appropriate receiving facility; and other activities related to the health and well-being

- 17 WHEREAS, EMS personnel provide access to quality pre-hospital emergency care that
- dramatically improves the survival and recovery rate of persons stricken with sudden illness
