A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Mr. Bobby Heath; and for other purposes.

4 Youth Building Campaign; and

6 in finance from the University of Georgia, and he is a graduate of the Georgia Banking
7 School and the American Banker's Associate Graduate School of Commercial Lending; and

25 remarkable children, Randy, Miller, and Rosemary; and

26 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
