A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 21, 2016, as Hair Loss Epidemic Summit Day in Georgia; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, recent studies conducted by the American Trichology Association confirm that
4 more than 100 million women, men, and children globally are losing their hair; and

5 WHEREAS, there is a serious hair loss epidemic caused by consumers who are being
6 deceived into buying using hair chemicals and other harmful cosmetic ingredients without
7 educational knowledge, which is accelerating the problem; and

8 WHEREAS, abusive hair weaving and the twisting and binding of hair too tightly can cause
9 traction alopecia which often leads to receding hair lines, premature balding, and even
10 permanent hair loss; and

11 WHEREAS, hair loss can also be attributed to underlying health conditions, such as stress,
12 drug abuse, chronic fatigue, poor diet, thyroid problems, high blood pressure, diabetes,
13 menopause and andropause, medication usage, and cancer treatments; and

14 WHEREAS, the National Trichology Training Institute is the only Trichology Institute in the
15 State of Georgia authorized by the Georgia Non-Public Postsecondary Education
16 Commission to issue a Diploma and Practitioners Certification in Trichology Healthcare; and

17 WHEREAS, the National Trichology Training Institute has successfully graduated hundreds
18 of Trichology students from more than 26 states in the United States of America and several
19 other countries to combat the hair loss epidemic; and

20 WHEREAS, the National Trichology Training Institute has established an aggressive
21 initiative to impede the progression of this epidemic, which affects millions, through its

22 National Hair Loss Epidemic Summit on February 21, 2016, to provide education and
23 intervention for beauty professionals and consumers.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
25 the members of this body recognize February 21, 2016, as Hair Loss Epidemic Summit Day
26 in Georgia and that millions of people are affected by the epidemic of hair loss.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
28 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to Connie
29 Judge-Johnson, Founder and President and Stephen Tyrone Johnson, Co-Founder of the
30 National Trichology Training Institute.
